#### LESSON PLAN:

- ❖ Ask the students how their lives today would be changed by these technologies.
- ❖ Challenge the students to create a new technology that they believe will help the world. The students could work in pairs or individually.
- ❖ Each new technology must accompanied by an illustration or 3 dimensional example as well as a written component describing the use of the invention and how they believe it will benefit the world. Each person or group would present their creation to the class.
